CUSTOMER SERVICE INSPECTION

I. Purpose. The Goforth Special Utility District is reponsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or polution which could result from improper pumbing practices. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the of the plumbing restrictions to insure the public heaalth and welfare. Each customer must sign this agreement before Goforth Special Utility District will begin service. In addition, when service to an existing connection has been suspended or terminated, the water system will not re-establish service unless it has a signed copy of this agreement.

- II. Plumbing Restrictions. The following undesirable plumbing practices are prohibited by state regulations.
 - A. No direct connection between the public drinking water supply ans a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contimination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
 - B. No cross connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminater at the service connection by the installation of an air-gap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.
 - C. No connection which allows condensing, cooling, or industrial process water to be returned to the public drink ing water supply is permitted.
 - D. No pipe or pipe fitting which contains nore than 8.0% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
 - E. No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2 percent lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.

	A. The Water System will maintain a copy of this agreement as long as the customer and / or the premises	is
	connected to the water system.	
	B. The customer shall allow his property to be inspected for possible cross-connections and other undesira	ıble
	plumbing practices. These inspections should be conducted by the water system or its designated agent per	iod to
	initiating service and periodically thereafter. The inspections should be conducted during the	
	the Water System's normal business hours.	
	C. The Water System shall be notify the customer in writing of any cross-connection or other undesirable	plumb
	ing practice which has been idenified during the intial inspection or the periodic reinspection.	
	D. The customer shall immediately correct any undesirable plumbing practice on his premises.	
	E. The customer shall, at his expenses, properly install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device	required
	by the Water System. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the Water System.	
IV.	Enforcement. If the customer fails to comply with the terms of the Service Agreement, the Water System	
	shall, at its option, either terminate service or properly install, test, and maintain an appropriate backflow p	reven
	tion device at the service connection. Any expenses associated with the enforcement of this agreement sha	
	billed to the customer.
