## Stage III – SEVERE Water Shortage Conditions

### Residential Meters Watering Schedule (5/8" x 3/4" Meter)

Addresses ending in an even number can water Monday/Thursday before 10am or after 8pm

Addresses ending in an odd number can water Tuesday/Friday before 10am or after 8pm

### COMMERCIAL METERS Watering Schedule

Irrigation meters sizes 3/4" and 2" can water Monday/Thursday

Irrigation meters sizes 1", 1 1/2", and 3" can water Tuesday/Friday

Irrigation by means of a hand-held hose, a faucet-filled bucket or watering can of five (5) gallons or less, or drip irrigation system is still allowed at any time.

Conserving water is about more than making sure everyone in our system has enough to drink or water their lawn. Most importantly, it is about safety. If water storage tanks drain and water pressure falls, it threatens everyone's safety in the event of a fire.

Someone using water outside of the posted schedule isn't just keeping their lawn greener, they're endangering everyone on the system, especially their own home.

The last thing that Goforth SUD wants to do is issue fines or restrict water flow for non-compliance. But, for the safety of all customers, if there is a disregard for watering schedules, there are penalties.

#### **Penalties for Non-Compliance:**

First violation – written warning

Second violation – \$250 fine

Third violation – \$550 fine and flow restrictor for 7 days (customer pays installation cost)

Subsequent violations – \$2,000 and flow restrictor for 7 days (customer pays installation cost)

Watering schedules are based on usage history, water supplies, and other Goforth SUD data. We appreciate all our customers – we can't do this without you! Following water schedules will help ensure a safe summer for all of us.
