Notice of Stage IV – CRITICAL Water Shortage Conditions

Beginning Monday March 24, 2025

Watering Schedule (before 10am or after 8pm ONLY):

	Residential Meters	COMMERCIAL METERS
Monday	Addresses ending in a 0 or 1	Irrigation meters size ³ / ₄ "
Tuesday	Addresses ending in a 2 or 3	Irrigation meters size 2"
Wednesday	Addresses ending in a 4 or 5	Irrigation meters size 1"
Thursday	Addresses ending in a 6 or 7	Irrigation meters size 1 ¹ / ₂ "
Friday	Addresses ending in an 8 or 9	Irrigation meters size 3"

- Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, airplane or other vehicle is permitted only on the assigned residential landscape watering days and times listed above.
- Use of water to fill, refill, or add to any private indoor or outdoor swimming pools, wading pools, or a Jacuzzi-type pool is prohibited.
- The use of water for construction purposes will be discontinued.

Irrigation by means of a hand-held hose, a faucet-filled bucket or watering can of five (5) gallons or less, or drip irrigation system is still allowed at any time.

The water supply for Goforth SUD may be in peril and physical restriction of water use and reporting of excessive users to Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation District may be required. Conserving water is about more than making sure everyone in our system has enough to drink or water their lawn. Most importantly, it is about safety. If water storage tanks drain and water pressure falls, it threatens everyone's safety in the event of a fire. Someone using water outside of the posted schedule isn't just keeping their lawn greener, they're endangering everyone on the system, especially their own home. The last thing that Goforth SUD wants to do is issue fines or restrict water flow for non-compliance. But, for the safety of all customers, if there is a disregard for watering schedules, there are penalties.

Penalties for Non-Compliance:

First violation – written warning Second violation – \$250 fine Third violation – \$550 fine and flow restrictor for 7 days (customer pays installation cost) Subsequent violations – \$2,000 and flow restrictor for 7 days (customer pays installation cost)

Watering schedules are based on usage history, water supplies, and other Goforth SUD data. We appreciate all our customers – we can't do this without you!
